TEP welcome applications from individual schools, groups of schools and colleges, LEA's, SETPOINTS and other agencies.

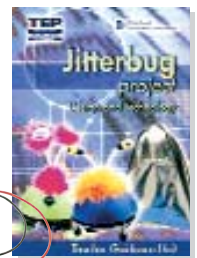
