

# TEP launches new Millennium projects

As part of the its Millennium Schools project, TEP has funded the development by Sheffield Hallam University of an exciting new series of key stage 3 teacher guidance units. Each of the 5 unit covers a single focussed practical task: Flat Flash and Battery Tester, Mouse Mat, Personal Organiser, Jitterbug, and CNC Torch. Each unit is designed to appeal to all D&T teachers, no matter what their level of expertise. Teachers may want to drop the design and make task directly into your existing scheme of work or be inspired to create a new task incorporating or developing elements of the teacher guidance unit.

The focussed practical task contained within each book encourages the good use of new and smart materials and work that enables students of all abilities to design and make functional,

useful and attractive take home products.

Schools participating in the TEP Millennium Schools project are already trialling the tasks, with much enthusiasm and great success.

Each full-colour book includes detailed learning aims and outcomes, resource and

equipment information, clear and illustrated explanations of processes involved, suggestions for learning support and extension and enrichment activities, an exemplar project plan and framework, references to the D&T programmes of study, and photocopiable templates for use in the classroom.
